B – Beaundesert Badge

- Fun and educational evening activities for boarders in Years 4, 5 and 6.

Bedtimes

- These are on display on your dormitory door.

Behaviour

- All members of the boarding community must respect each other.

C – Concerns / Complaints

- We all have worries or concerns from time to time, some of which are important.
- You may witness an incident where someone else is treated unkindly in which case you must report it.
- The following people are available for you to talk to: Houseparents, Matrons, Sisters, Gap Students, Form Tutor, Mr and Mrs Womersley, Mr MacIntosh or friends, indeed any member of staff or the School's Independent Listener,

- We encourage pupils to raise problems; you will not be in trouble if you do so. You may want to make a formal complaint to the Headmaster in writing. The complaint will be dealt with and you may be asked to talk to the Headmaster.

D – Dressing Gowns and Slippers

- These must be in school and should be worn around the House.

DVDs or downloaded images

- the playing of any sort, without permission, is strictly forbidden.

E – Evening

- There are many activities on offer in the evenings in your free time.

Electrical Possessions

- Electrical items may not be put on charge.
- Equipment which is internet enabled is not permitted at school.
- Laptops and i-pads are not allowed in the boarding house. E-readers (ie Kindle) are permitted. Please refer to the Acceptable Use Policy.

F – Fire

- If the alarm sounds please leave the building as quickly as possible by your nearest exit.
- Never leave a member of your dormitory asleep.
- Assemble, in silence, in the front courtyard where a roll call will be taken.
- Do not re-enter the building until told to do so by a member of staff.

Flexi-boarding

- Three or less nights per week mean you are a flexi-boarder.

G – Games

- There are plenty of different games for you to play in the evenings, including the Nintendo Wii.

H – Happiness

- This is the most important part of being in the boarding house and if you see anyone upset you must let a member of staff know.

I – Illness.

- Everyone will look after you if you are ill. Also see R for Red Buttons and S for Sisters.

J – Joining in.

Beauesert Boarders make up one big family and we hope everyone looks out for each other and no one is left out.

K – Keeping Safe

- Security locks on all external doors are there for your safekeeping. Fire doors are kept shut at night and fire practice is undertaken on a regular basis.

Kit

- All weekly and flexi-boarders are given a detailed kit list.

L – Listening

Senior Matron, who is helped by a team of Matrons and our Gap Matron are here to do their best to help you with anything!

Laundry

- Baskets are placed on each landing every night for laundry.

M – Mornings

- A member of staff will wake you up at 7.15pm.
- 7.20am means that it is time to get up, get dressed and begin to tidy your dormitory.
- Breakfast is from 7.35am.

N – Naming

- ALL possessions brought into school should be named.

Newspapers, books and magazines

- Are provided for you to read. If you borrow one please return it.

O – ‘Outstanding’

- ISI (**I**ndependent **S**chools **I**nspectorate) Inspection report, November 2011 quotes: “The quality of boarding education is outstanding and fully meets the school’s aims.”

P – Personal Possessions

- It is important that everyone respects each other’s property.
- Never ‘borrow’ items without the owner’s permission.
- Photography is not permitted.

Q – Quiet Reading

- Before ‘Lights-Out’ there will be a period of quiet reading.

- Learning (not writing) of school work is also allowed for the first 15 minutes.

R – Red Buttons

- If you feel ill after lights out you will need to use a red button to call a Matron.

S – Sisters

- They are here to look after your health.
- There is a surgery in the morning after breakfast and in the evening after tea.

Snug

- A place to relax in your free time.

Suggestion Box

- If you have any ideas you would like to improve your boarding experience pop a note in the box.

T – Telephones

- These are available for your use during the evenings until it is time to go up to your dormitory and first thing in the morning.

Tuck

- Boarders will occasionally be given tuck, provided by the school.
- Please do not bring tuck into school.

U – Unwell

- Sister or Matron will let your parents know if you are unwell.
- We have a room for children to lie down, rest and recover in peace, which is beside the surgery.

V – Valuables

- Please do not bring valuable items in to the Boarding House. All watches should be named – please ask Matrons. Other items **must be** labelled. Weekly boarders may have a lockable box.

W – Water Dispensers

- Drinking water dispensers are available in the Boarding House.

X – X-Factor
