



# A STATEMENT OF PRINCIPLES

Whilst embracing the aims and objectives of the whole school policies on equal opportunity, anti-bullying and behavior, the following are the ten principles on which boarding at Beauesert Park is based:

- The development of the whole person and the communication of values are vital.
- In keeping with the nature of the school, boarding is based upon mutual respect for all member of the community.
- Every boarder has the right to be able to work, play and relax free from any form of intimidation, bullying or abuse.
- There should be equality of opportunity and respect for all boarders, regardless of ethnicity, culture, gender, age or disability.
- Every boarder and every member of staff is to be treated as an individual and with respect by other pupils and by staff.
- Although living corporately, staff and boarders acknowledge the right of each other to privacy.
- Every boarder has the right to extend his/her intellectual growth in an atmosphere of positive encouragement and in conditions that are conducive to work.
- All boarders should be encouraged and supported to develop spiritually, culturally, morally and socially during their time in the House.
- Strong links with parents are seen as essential ingredient in the support and development of every boarder at Beauesert Park.
